A motion was made by Keith Kazmark and seconded by Kevin Galland, to approve the minutes of the Executive Board Meeting Minutes of October 14, 2016 as amended; unanimously approved.

Laura Flagg, Rutgers Continuing Studies provided state exam information from the October 5, 2016 results as follows:

She also provided an update on the Information and Records Management Chapter Revisions and provided the following steps to implement the new chapter in class:

- Transition online class to new learning management system
- Update online course to include ne content and activities

- Discuss flow of course material with instructors
- Identify new exam questions (for in-class and state exam)
- Additional conversations to discuss course hours required and the use of computer lab
- Goal to implement in class by fall 2017

Reports:

Executive Director

Mr. Popkin advised that Rutgers declined to conduct the legal review of the Study Guide/Desk Reference. It was felt that it would be an on-going process that could take 2 to 4 years to complete. It was questioned whether a professional review in its entirety would be necessary; a price quote would be needed in order to make a final determination on the matter. The matter would be placed on the next agenda for further discussion.

Mr. Popkin gave an update on the Legal Defense Fund for which there are currently 267 members. The yearly renewal currently generates \$5,000 for the fund and the current balance is \$136,000. Since the balance is rather high for a non-profit organization, he suggested that either more money is spent (possibly lunch meeting seminar for the members) or that less money is taken in for new members. There have been only 3 inquiries in recent months which did not result in any further action. It was determined that Mr. Popkin would speak with Mr. Weinstein for a written opinion on the health of the fund and if in agreement, a question and answer session would be arranged for the membership.

He discussed the NJ Delegation at the IIMC Conference to be held in Canada in May. It was determined that he would make dinner arrangements for the delegates and that each would contribute money towards it.

Lastly, he advised that he and Dina would currently working on a couple of proposals relative to the 2018 conference. More details would be provided at a future date.

Secretary

Ms. Gore gave an update on the cost of a bus charter service for the NJ delegates attending the IIMC Conference. It was determined that due to many factors involved, it would not be undertaken.

Attorney

Mr. Hebert provided an article relative to the rise of short-term overnight rentals and the impact on municipalities. While the short-term rental business industry is still in a state of improvement and development, there may be repercussions for towns that choose to step in and regulate, or chooses to opt out and avoid regulation.

Treasurer

Ms. Pflugfelder reported that as of February 28, 2017 there were 725 members, including 50 Honorary Memberships (non-paying retirees), have registered their membership with the Association. The Budget, General Ledger and Conference Reports made part of the minutes.

2nd Vice President

Mr. Galland advised that currently there were 173 registrants (inclusive of 33 paid & 9 scholarship winners) for the upcoming conference. After discussion, it was determined that the 1st alternate's (free scholarship & need based) should be contacted.

1st Vice President

Ms. Zawadski advised the pins for the IIMC Conference were received. It was determined that Ms. Pflugfelder would be responsible for the distribution of the pins. She advised that the final plans for the presentation of Clerk of the Year were completed along with the finalization of the scanners and conveners for the conference.

Immediate Past President

Mr. Kazmark proposed changes to update the MCANJ Policy Manual regarding eligibility for the Clerk of the Year Award. After discussion, the following language was agreed upon:

The Municipal Clerk of the Year Award shall be awarded by the MCANJ Executive Board to an individual who has made significant contributions to the association.

Nominations for the Municipal Clerk of the Year Award will be accepted from Executive Board members as well as from the general membership. Nominations must be made in writing on the prescribed form.

- Nominees must be active members of the MCANJ, currently employed as Municipal Clerks and tenured in their positions. (Active member is defined as one who is registered and paid their dues within four months of the new fiscal year, or no later than October 31); or a registered honorary member of MCANJ, within the first 12 months of retirement.
- Current members of the Executive Board and former recipients of the award are not eligible.
- Qualifications must include activities within MCANJ and may include contributions to the profession, as well as related community and volunteer work.

President

Ms. Szabo advised that she was pleased with the online components for the exhibitors and sponsors for the upcoming Annual Conference. There were 9 applications for the style makeover received (7 women/2men) and that there were 10 commitments received for silent auction items. The newly created Need-Based Scholarship was very popular with 23 applications being received for 5 awards.

She also provided an update on legislation and recent decisions as follows:

- S1046 (OPRA) & S-1045 (OPMA) no further movement since December, however it was felt there was still concerns with the proposed legislation.
- A-4532 (OPRA) to eliminate personal information from being distributed through an OPRA request which was brought forth by Assemblyman DeAngelo; a letter of support was provided to the sponsor.
- A-4429 (Prietro/Bramnick) & S-2855 (Whelan/Doherty) "Electronic Publication of Legal Notices Act" permit publication of legal notices by government agencies and persons on official government notice websites instead of newspapers. While these bills were pulled from the agenda in late December, both the Governor and speaker indicated the initiative remains a priority that may be revisited in 2017.
- Appellate Division Kean Federation of Teachers v. Morell, Kean University's Board of Trustees
 - 1) Adopt a meeting schedule that will enable them to make its meeting minutes "promptly available" under NJSA 10:4014

The court held that "a public body is required to send out a Rice notice any time it has placed on its agenda any matters "involving the employment, terms and conditions of employment, evaluation of the performance of, promotion, or disciplining of any specific prospective public officer or employee or employee or current public officer or employee employed or appointed by the public body.

Lastly, the Governor signed into law PL. 2017. c 26 which preempts municipal regulation of some taxi services such as Uber and Lyft. This new law exempts ride for hire services from local regulation.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Ms. Pflugfedler to adjourn; carried. Meeting was adjourned at 11:10 a.m.
